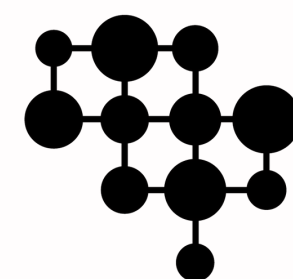

intellectual and developmental disabilities • attention deficits • poor social understanding • hyperactivity poor coordination and planning • poor muscle tone • verbal working memory deficits • receptive language deficits • executive functioning deficits • difficulty organising and planning • slower processing speed • inability to learn from the consequences of their behaviour • growth deficiencies • sometimes unique facial features • damage to the central nervous system • permanent impairment of brain function
